Note

1. The governments of municipality may regulate the least numbers of crews of fishing vessel exceeding 24 tons but less than 100 tons with its authority. Without regulating, the fishing vessels shall comply to this Appendix. For the fishing vessel less than 20 tons, the least numbers of crews shall be regulated by the municipal/county/city competent authority.
2. A fishing vessel which exceeds 12 meters, but less than 24 meters length overall and operates on limited waters may be allowed to sail with personnel assignment of 1 Captain and 1 R.O.C national crew or 1 foreign crew hired by “Employment Services Act” if any one of the following conditions is complied:
 - (1) When the captain withholds Fishing Vessel Officer Certificate on both navigation and engineering units which the vessels shall assigned.
 - (2) When the Captain holds Fishing Vessel Officer Certificate on navigation unit and the Certificate on completion of the training course of engineering officer on the same class of fishing vessel.
 - (3) When the Chief Engineer (Engineering Supervisor) holds Fishing Vessel Officer Certificate on engineering unit and the Certificate on completion of the training course of navigation officer on the same class of fishing vessel.

3. The aforesaid Certificate on completion of the training course shall not be over 5 years after signed up, except having the document for sailing and working profile at least 1 year in 5 years.
4. Apart from the Captain, a fishing vessel operates in unlimited waters may employ Overseas Employment of Foreign Crew Members or Mainland China Crew Members of its personnel assignment with the qualification of Officer certified by his/her national country .
5. If a fishing vessel which fulfills the Officer personnel assignment given by 2. and 4., the owner of fishing vessel shall report to the Competent Authority for registration, and the Competent Authority shall further report to the central government and acknowledge the local coast guard.
6. The municipal/county/city competent authority shall register navigating or engineering profile for the Captain or Chief Engineer (Engineering Supervisor) stipulated to 2. at the applicant's will.
7. Before this Regulation on 23 August, 2021, a fishing vessel exceed 24 meters operates in domestic bases (limited waters) have reported to the governments of municipality, county (city) hiring crews of foreign national by the "Employment Services Act" as a assistant of engineering shall be with personnel assignment of this Appendix from 1 August, 2022.
