Notes	1. Pursuant to the proviso to Paragraph 1, Article 29 of the Animal Industry Act and the Announcement No. 1061505452 issued on June 28, 2017, cattle and sheep slaughtered for consumption in Islamic (Muslim) Eid al-Adha rituals may be exempt from the requirement to be slaughtered in slaughterhouses upon approval by the municipal or county (city) government having jurisdiction over the location of the slaughter and the issuance of relevant approval document. 2. Applications must be submitted by duly established and registered Islamic (Muslim) juridical persons, using the prescribed application form, at least seven (7) days prior to the ritual to the competent municipal or county (city) government having jurisdiction over the location of the ritual. 3. Any person who slaughters cattle or sheep outside a slaughterhouse without meeting the prescribed requirements is subject to a fine of NT\$100,000 to NT\$500,000 pursuant to Subparagraph 2 of Paragraph 1 of Article 38 of the Animal Industry Act. The carcasses and viscera of such cattle or sheep will also be confiscated pursuant to Paragraph 6 of the same Article. 4. Animals must be slaughtered in accordance with Subparagraph 1 of Paragraph 1 of Article 13 of the Animal Protection Act and in a humane manner that minimizes pain and suffering. They must not be slaughtered in a public place or any place accessible to the public. Any person who violates these requirements is subject to a fine of NT\$15,000 to NT\$75,000 pursuant to Subparagraph 4 of Paragraph 1 of Article 30 of the same Act.
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
