Notes

1. Any person who slaughters poultry outside a slaughterhouse without meeting the prescribed requirements are subject to a fine of NT\$100,000 to NT\$500,000 pursuant to Subparagraph 2, Paragraph 1 of Article 38 of the Animal Industry Act. The carcasses and viscera of the slaughtered poultry will also be confiscated pursuant to Paragraph 6 of the same Article.
2. Slaughter must be conducted in accordance with Subparagraph 1, Paragraph 1 of Article 13 of the Animal Protection Act, using humane methods that minimize pain and suffering, and must not be conducted in public places or places accessible to the public. Violators are subject to a fine of NT\$15,000 to NT\$75,000 pursuant to Subparagraph 4, Paragraph 1 of Article 30 of the same Act.
3. Any person who disagrees with this administrative disposition may file an administrative appeal by submitting a written administrative appeal through this Government to the Ministry of Agriculture within thirty (30) days from the day following receipt of this administrative disposition, in accordance with Articles 14 and 58 of the Administrative Appeal Act.
