Notes	1. Pursuant to the proviso to Paragraph 1 of Article 29 of the Animal Industry Act and the Ministry of Agriculture Announcement No. 1131893637 (issued on August 2, 2024), chickens, ducks, and geese slaughtered for kosher poultry may be exempted from the requirement to be slaughtered in a slaughterhouse. This exemption applies only upon approval by the municipality or county (city) government having jurisdiction over the location of slaughter and issuance of the relevant approval document. 2. The applicant must submit this application to the municipality or county (city) government having jurisdiction over the location of slaughter at least seven (7) days before the scheduled slaughter date. 3. Any person who slaughters poultry outside a slaughterhouse without meeting the prescribed requirements is subject to a fine of NT\$20,000 to NT\$100,000 pursuant to Subparagraph 1, Paragraph 2 of Article 38 of the Animal Industry Act. The carcasses and viscera of such poultry are also confiscated pursuant to Paragraph 6 of the same Article. 4. Animals must be slaughtered in accordance with Subparagraph 1 of Paragraph 1 of Article 13 of the Animal Protection Act and in a humane manner that minimizes pain and suffering. The animals must not be slaughtered in a public place or any place accessible to the public. Any person who violates these requirements is subject to a fine of NT\$15,000 to NT\$75,000 pursuant to Subparagraph 4 of Paragraph 1 of Article 30 of the same Act.
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
